Update 5.0.1.16 is Available for Downloading

The updated version 5.0.1.16 is now available for download. This update fixes some bugs that were discovered recently that were driving all of us nuts.

Setting or Changing Skier Event Class

A bug was found in the slalom event scoring panel in the Active Skier box showing the tournament class for the skier being scored. This is the box that allows us to change the class for a skier to a different type. The bug was not allowing the change to take place and this has now been corrected.

A quick review for setting or changing the tournament class for a skier:

1. Before the tournament begins go to the Tournament tab > check the event to work on > choose All or the individual age division or group that you want to work on > click refresh. In the Class column you can set the class for the skier in your selected event and when you are done > click on the Save icon so you do not lose your revisions! Follow these steps for all of your events and everything will be set for scoring your events in the tournament.
2. If you are scoring a skier on the water and the you choose to change the class of the skier, you can do it before or during the run and when you move on to the next skier your changes will be in the database. The caveat here is that the change will only apply to the current round that you are scoring in.
3. If you change the class of a skier in the scoring panel and want it to apply to the following rounds, then you can go back to step 1 above and the change will apply to the subsequent rounds to be scored.

4. Warning, if you have finished the tournament and in your final audit of the scores find that a skiers class is incorrect and they have scores recorded, then you cannot make the correction in the Running Order tabs for any events, you have to make the correction in the affected rounds event scoring panel.
5. Sounds complicated, but is really a very easy and structured way to work through these issues.
