Update 6.0.1.0 is Available for Downloading

The updated version 6.0.1.0 is now available for download. This update contains more updates needed to comply with the AWSA and IWWF 2020 rules.

Added Boys and Girls 5

The new Boys and Girls 5 divisions have been added to the program for event scoring along with the new NOPS data.

IWWF Senior Divisions Expanded

All of the IWWF Senior age division codes are now in the program and available for use in the AWSA and IWWF rules sets for class L tournaments, which except for over 35 world championships are the class that the older divisions ski in. Dave still has to do a complete review of the overall calculation standards for each of the events, but this will be done in the next few weeks and included in the next update.

NCWSA Jump Placement Calculations Revised

The placement standards for NCWSA Jump events for men and women has been revised. Effective immediately, any jumper that has several passes and at least one fall will be included in the placements for the event and receive the appropriate points for the Team computations. The key to this is that the skier had a fall, which means they went over the ramp but did not complete the jump. The fall counts as a scored jump. If a skier takes three passes by the ramp and does not go over the ramp, they do not have a score and therefore will not be included in the skier count and receive placement points.
