## **Export Officials Work File For Quick Review**

Scorers have been asking for a quick way to view the Officials Work record file that will be produced during the final reports package (sanction#OD.txt). This file is now ready for you to review and if you go to the main toolbar and click on Tournaments > Officials Work Record > in the toolbar on this screen you will see Export Credit File, click on that and the file will be produced and placed in your tournament folder. You can now open this file and review/print for your use during the tournament.

## **Records Table Updated**

The records table for AWSA, NCWSA and IWWF has been updated to include all records through mid-September of this year.

## **2018 NOPS Table**

The NOPS Table has been updated to include the values for the 2018 skiing season. If you need to produce an updated scorebook, open the tournament and then re-run the two scorebooks in the list and then click on the Tournament Package icon at the bottom of the list to produce a new zip package.
