Update 5.0.1.0 is Available for Downloading

The updated version 5.0.1.0 is now available for download. Several glitches in the slalom score entry and editing were reported and Dave has been able to identify and fix the problems so they should not reoccur in the future.

Event Summary Sorting Updated

The slalom, trick and jumping summaries have been updated to include the Event Group in the options available for sorting.

Sorting By Boats Now An Option In trick Running Orders

You can now sort your trick running orders by the Boat brand/type available for use at the tournament along with the other sorting options available.

Run Order Icon Removed From Events

The Running Order icon has been removed from the slalom, trick and jump toolbars. This icon produced the old DOS running order file in a text format for copying and pasting. The program is now producing a tab delimited file that contains more data for you to use in producing your running orders for large tournaments. The data can be copied and pasted into your Excel spreadsheets for editing and use or you can click on the "print" icon and print the running orders from the default setup. Be sure to select the divisions that you want to print before you click on the print command and then click on the "refresh" icon to update your selection (s). To save paper and ink, print the selected running orders to a PDF document so that you can review the document before actually printing out you copies.

All f the records have been updated as of this morning.
